Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They began as a small machine shop initially employing four people. Sales for their first year of operation totaled \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and other parts. Throughout 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to forty staff and their annual sales volume had risen to \$330,000. At present, Cascade is one of the top worldwide producers within the material handling industry.

Design and production of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this new company to aggressively engage in better business opportunities. Throughout the last sixty years, the trade of material handling has developed into a very sophisticated field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its growth. Cascade presently continues to grow as the leader provider of forklift accessories and different related products. The company feels certain in their ability to be able to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding buyer's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive in the global market.

Through the nineteen fifties, Cascade began to make, design, and advertise its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was made in the year 1956, so as to accommodate all the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's present center of operations. Following 15 years of business, total workers reached 180 workers and sales had reached nearly \$2,300,000.

The next manufacturing plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, Midland. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry when the company recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In the year 1964, the company changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in 1965, the company went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing amenities throughout the continental USA to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already existing plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Midland. Cascade products are manufactured internationally thanks to many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new facility was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is made to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and the year 1997 with the impressive acquisition of five companies, including the worldwide leader in forks, the Kenhar Corporation.
